Program Requirements

- Requires a previously completed Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree
- Complete a minimum of 120 credit hours
- Minimum of 30 credit hours of upper division coursework (300/400 level)
- Final 30 credit hours completed at Lincoln College
- C or better in all required lower division general education courses
- Final Lincoln College cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or above
